# NATO PA's 64<sup>th</sup> Annual Session Halifax, Nova Scotia, Canada

November 16 – 19, 2018



The Parliament of Canada, under the auspices of the Canadian NATO Parliamentary Association, hosted the 64th Annual Session of the NATO Parliamentary Assembly (NATO PA) in Halifax, Nova Scotia, from 16-19 November 2018.

The NATO PA is an inter-parliamentary organization of legislators from the national parliaments of the 29-member countries of NATO, as well as 14 associate member countries. It serves as a liaison for NATO and member parliaments and strengthens parliamentary awareness, understanding, and oversight of key defence and security issues. The Annual Session is the NATO PA's largest annual event, where more than 800 delegates, experts, and observers from NATO member countries and partners from North Africa, the Middle East and Central Asia generally participate.

The Annual Session consists of a number of events and can include: meetings of the NATO PA Standing Committee, the NATO PA Bureau, thematic committee and subcommittee meetings, Plenary Sessions, ad hoc committee meetings, political group meetings, and bilateral meetings between delegations.

Each of the NATO PA's five thematic committees<sup>1</sup> and subcommittees<sup>2</sup> meet to discuss, vote on, and adopt reports and related resolutions. There is no overarching theme to guide the meeting or report topics. These decisions are made by the Secretariat's Committee Directors in conjunction with the Chairs, Vice-Chairs, and Rapporteurs of each committee. However, the host country typically puts forward expert speakers (government officials, academics, etc.) who offer presentations to each of the committees.

The resolutions adopted during these meetings reflect a broad range of subjects, and become policy recommendations voted on by the whole Assembly during Plenary Session. While these recommendations are not legally binding, they are widely distributed to governments and parliaments of NATO member and associate member nations. The NATO Secretary General also provides a written response to each policy recommendation.

The Plenary Sessions represent an opportunity for the leadership of the host country to showcase the importance of the Alliance to that country, government policy or practices, or discuss current or future defence commitments

These recommendations are not legally binding, but they are widely distributed to governments and parliaments of NATO member and associate member nations. In addition, the NATO Secretary General provides a written response to each policy recommendation.

There are currently eight sub-committees: the Sub-committee on Democratic Governance, the Sub-Committee on Transatlantic Defence and Security Co-operation, the Sub-Committee on Future Security and Defence Capabilities, the Sub-Committee on Transition and Development, the Sub-Committee on Transatlantic Economic Relations, the Sub-Committee on NATO Partnerships, the Sub-Committee on Transatlantic Relations, and the Sub-Committee on Technology Trends and Security.
