ParlAmericas' Canadian Section meets with leaders in Brazil's new National Congress and Cabinet

Canadian parliamentarians meet with high-level officials and business leaders in Brasilia and São Paulo

OTTAWA – Wednesday, April 24, 2019— Today the <u>Honourable Bob Nault</u>, P.C., M.P., President of <u>ParlAmericas</u> and Chair of the <u>Canadian Section of ParlAmericas</u>, leads a delegation to Brasilia and São Paulo, Brazil for bilateral meetings. Mr. Nault is accompanied by the <u>Honourable David M. Wells</u>, Senator, the <u>Honourable Jim Munson</u>, Senator, the <u>Honourable Kellie Leitch</u>, P.C., M.P., and Ms. <u>Brenda Shanahan</u>, M.P.

In Brasilia, delegates are meeting with Brazil's <u>Minister of Human Rights</u>, <u>Family and Women</u>, Damares Alves, the <u>Speaker</u> of the Federal Senate, Davi Alcolumbre, and a number of members of the National Congress, including those who serve on the foreign affairs committees in the <u>Federal Senate</u> and the <u>Chamber of Deputies</u>. In addition, they will participate in a roundtable discussion about Indigenous issues. In São Paulo, delegates will meet with business leaders, academics and representatives of civil society organizations.
