In response to the motion adopted by the Special Joint Committee on the Declaration of Emergency on May 31, 2022, concerning the production of documents related to the Government's invocation of the *Emergencies Act*, please find enclosed bilingual copies of assessments created by the Privy Council Office (PCO).

The materials in this package were created by PCO between January 23, 2022 and February 14, 2022 and have been assembled for the Committee as follows:

- **Daily Situation Reporting:** PCO's Crisis Management Cell produced multiple reports throughout the period of time noted above. This package includes the reports from February 8 to February 14, 2022. Reports from January 23 to February 7, 2022, will be provided to the Committee as soon as translation of those reports is complete.

These documents have been reviewed and, where necessary, redacted to protect third party information, and law enforcement and investigations. These Crisis Management Cell reports contain photographs of the crowds and vehicles around 80 Wellington Street and these photos have been redacted to protect the locations of security cameras from public disclosure.

On April 25, 2022, the Government established the Public Order Emergency Commission, an independent public inquiry, to support transparency about the use of the *Emergencies Act*. In response to a request from the Commission, the Government has decided, on an exceptional and voluntary basis, that it will provide the Commission with the inputs that were before Cabinet when it considered the circumstances that led to the declaration of the public order emergency.

The documents that have been produced to address the Special Joint Committee's motion noted above were gathered prior to this decision having taken effect. Therefore, the Privy Council Office will work with relevant departments and agencies to ensure that, if there are any Cabinet confidences meeting the terms of the motion, they are reviewed in light of this decision, translated, and produced to the Committee within a reasonable time.

Please find attached additional bilingual documents from the Privy Council Office (PCO) in relation to the motion adopted by the Special Joint Committee on the Declaration of the Emergency on May 31, 2022 concerning the Government's invocation of the Emergencies Act.





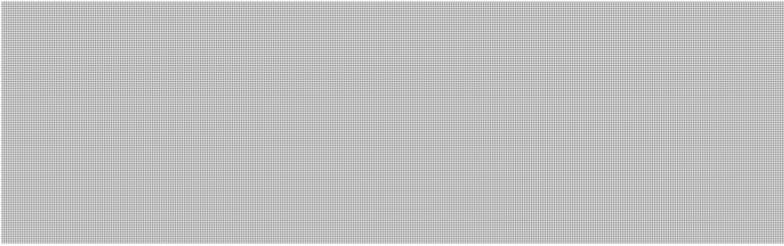
