Canadian Section of the Canada-U.S. Inter-Parliamentary Group to Participate in a Meeting with U.S. and Mexican Legislators

From 1-2 December 2014, Mr. Gord Brown, M.P., House of Commons Co-Chair of the Canadian Section of the Canada-United States Inter-Parliamentary Group, will lead a delegation to a meeting of federal legislators from the three North American countries in Washington, D.C. The all-party delegation will also include two Canadian Senators and three members of the House of Commons.
